



County Accepting Applications for Planning Commission, Economic Development and Board of Public Works Members

The Cass County Board of Commissioners is seeking candidates for appointment to the Cass County Planning Commission, the Cass County Economic Development Corporation and the Cass County Board of Public Works. The nine-member County Planning Commission meets once a month. The Planning Commission functions as an advisory board for the purposes of reviewing township zoning ordinances, amendments and has duties as set forth in the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, MCL 125.3801. The twelve-member Economic Development Corporation Board meets once a month. The purpose of the EDC is to address issues of unemployment, retention and attraction of talent and to redevelop qualified properties to strengthen and revitalize the economy of Cass County. The seven-member Board of Public Works meets once a month. The Board of Public Works functions as the oversight body for utility construction projects within the Board's jurisdiction – mainly water and sewer services installed and operated according to county-municipality agreements.

There is an appointment application form available at www.casscountymi.org or at the Cass County Administrator's Office, Cass County Building, 120 N. Broadway, Suite 116, Cassopolis (8am-5pm, M-F). Compensation for the Planning Commission and the Board of Public Works is a \$20.00 per diem and mileage. There is no compensation for the Economic Development Corporation.
