

## **DOG LAW ENFORCEMENT POLICY**

1. The Sheriff and Administrator will recommend a person to be appointed Animal Control Director by the Board of Commissioners.
2. The Director will work under the Sheriff's oversight and direction and be responsible for the animal control operation under the Dog Law Enforcement Ordinance and all applicable state and local laws and regulations.
3. The Director will be a non-union salaried employee and the other department employees will remain as employees under the general unit contract. The Board of Commissioners will establish the salary for the Director.
4. The program will be funded from the Animal Control budget of the general fund.
5. The Sheriff will report to the County Administrator and Board of Commissioners on the performance of the animal control program and prepare a budget each year.
6. The proposal may be cancelled by the Board of Commissioners or Sheriff at any time provided a sixty-day notice is given.
